Proposal to the Petanque England Annual General Meeting to be held on Saturday 14th August 2021

Proposed Resolution: -

"This AGM believes that life membership of PE is the highest honour that a Petanque England member can receive.

Unfortunately, in practice it appears that some regions are refusing full rights to our Life Members unless they pay the relevant regional precept that applies.

This AGM resolves to encourage PE regions to issue full membership rights to any Life Members they may have in the Region without any requirement to pay precept in recognition of the reasons why Life Membership was granted by the national body in the first place.

This AGM recognises that it is not within the power of the national body to waive regional precepts, but if it transpires that a Region is insisting on the payment of the precept by Life Members, then this AGM resolves to request that the national body makes that payment on behalf of the Life Member concerned with the payment or payments identified in PE's national accounts along with the identity of the Region concerned."
