This is a crucial leadership role with duties including creating, disseminating, and delivering the vision, mission, and future objectives for the company. The president has a key leadership but must be able to work in a collegiate way. They will be adept at preparing and delivering a strategic plan for the organisation, meeting with and working alongside members of the Board of Directors to organise budgets, manage the development of our sport, ensure compliance, and act as the face of Pétanque when working with other National Sporting Bodies. They will be well known by regions and members at grass roots level.

The President should ideally be a charismatic leader with a clear vision for the sport and proven leadership experience. They should be able to articulate their vision for the future and development of Pétanque.
