The Vice President

The Vice President is an executive member of the board assuming the role of senior leader in the absence of the President. This is a key leadership role with duties including supporting the President in delivering a strategic plan for the organisation. They will also work the Board of Directors to plan and manage the development of our sport, ensuring value for money and best use of time and the skills of members. The Vice President should be an organised person with proven leadership experience and the ability to articulate a shared vision for the future and development of Pétanque in England.

The Essential Qualities of the Vice President:

- Leadership experience
- Good organisational skills
- Ability to plan and run meetings
- Wide knowledge and experience of the game
- Understanding of organisations & how they work
- Good communication & interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of roles and responsibilities
- Be familiar with club constitution
- Ability to Chair a meeting
- Passion for Pétanque
- Long term member of Pétanque England (Min of three years)
- Good verbal, written and IT skills

The Desirable Qualities of the Vice President

- Knowledge of company rules and regulations
- An ability to plan strategically
- A good knowledge of the articles of association
- A good knowledge of Pétanque England policies
- Ability to work with others
- Experience of chairing a committee
- Time and Ability to travel around the UK
- Ability to present ideas or information
- Time available to fulfil the role

The Vice President may also be required to take on tasks and roles commensurate with and in line with the role as requested by the President or Executive. They are responsible to the President

Candidates might also bring to the role something extra that adds quality to the position
